




Things to see

9 ways to get the most out of AWFS

Tips to help you get the most out of your AWFS Fair experience

The year's largest woodworking show in North America, AWFS will play host to more than 420 exhibitors and thousands of attendees, July 20-23 in the newly completed West Hall of the Las Vegas Convention Center.

To get the most out of the experience, here are 9 tips for navigating the biennial show.

1. Logistics

AWFS Fair opens July 20 and runs through July 23, with a wide range of educational options. Show hours are 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday, and 9:00 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Friday. The exhibits will be in the West Hall of the Las Vegas Convention Center, 3150 Paradise Road, Las Vegas, Nevada.

For those who prefer to drive, Limited parking is available at the LVCC.

2. Plan ahead

Even before you arrive each day, check out the exhibitor list for a list of companies and their booth numbers to visit. In addition to the AWFS Fair website, AWFSFair.org, a great source of information for show news and events are media sites, such as WoodworkingNetwork.com and industry publications, such as FDMC, Closets & Organized Storage and the special edition Pre-Show Planner.

Create a list of (1) exhibitors you absolutely must see; and (2) exhibitors that you would like to see. Be sure to leave time in your schedule for exploring the new products, technology and services on display on the show floor.

Following are several ways to access the exhibitor list: download AWFS Fair's app or go to the AWFS Fair website, AWFSFair.org, for up-todate information. You can see a copy of the exhibitor list in the Pre-Show Planner. Also check out FDMC's July



edition, Closets & Organized Storage magazine's July/August issue for more information on the show.

3. Comfort is key

Be sure to wear comfortable shoes to the show. The West Hall at the LVCC stretches across 600,000 square feet, with more than 420 exhibitors spread throughout the space. The show will operate in accordance with current safety guidelines from the CDC and local government.

4. Available resources

In addition to the show website, AWFSFair.org, and the official fair directory you'll receive at the show, another valuable resource for locating exhibitors is the "world's largest" AWFS Fair floor plan and exhibitors' list published in this issue. Use these valuable tools to plan the most efficient routes for booth visits.

5. Educational opportunities

The College of Woodworking Knowledge offers two dozen educational sessions related to: Culture and Workforce, Business Management; Cabinet, Millwork & Furniture; and Innovation & Technology. The sessions take place on the second floor, in room W201-212 to 209-225.

6. Special exhibits & demos

Be sure to check out the products entered in the AWFS Visionary Awards. Winners will be announced at the show on Thursday, July 22 at 9:15 a.m.

The new fabricator and installer/assembler challenge will have attendees fighting to beat the clock to assemble and install a custom-designed storage space on the show floor. See page 20 for details.

Also new this year is Tool Tour, a

self-guided journey of select exhibitors specializing in innovative hand and power tool equipment, and Safety Zone, featuring exhibitors specializing in shop and personal safety equipment.

Speaking of new, don't forget to stop by the always popular New Product Showcase.

And be sure to check out the Industry 4.0 Showcase highlighting the technology that will influence the future of manufacturing.

9. Network

Thousands of wood industry professionals are expected to be in attendance at AWFS Fair. Take advantage of the on-site expertise from thousands of industry suppliers as well as your peers.

Don't hesitate to ask questions, look for tips or seek advice, and take advantage of the opportunity to inquire about the products and services that can help improve your business.

AWFS Education hands-on and face-to-face

How can you get the most from the College of Woodworking Knowledge at AWFS?

Just about everybody has about had enough of endless Zoom meetings and "virtual" education programs. Now it's time for the real thing.

The College of Woodworking Knowledge, the extensive education program offered by AWFS, is ready and waiting to fill your business education needs with the kind of face-to-face and hands-on training opportunities that have been non-existent through the pandemic. But as enthusiastic as you might be to take advantage of this program, you need to consider a number of tips to get the most out of it.

Study and choose

AWFS CWWK features dozens of industry experts talking and presenting on a wide range of issues to address just about any question you have about the industry, running your business, and producing your products. That means there are far more seminars and education events available at the show than any one person could possibly attend. That means you need study the list and make a plan.

Comb through the listings to see what topics strike your interests and business needs. Then look further to learn about the presenters and what's to be covered.

Plan your days

Make sure you put alerts into your cell phone to remind you in plenty of time to get from the show floor to the seminar without having to rush. It's really easy to get engrossed in displays on the show floor and forget you planned to attend a seminar.

Or even worse, you find yourself at the farthest end of the hall when it's time for your seminar to start. That's



why it's also a good idea to coordinate your show floor plan with your seminar plan, and that's not just by location. If you are attending a seminar such as CNC Essentials on Wednesday afternoon, you might want to coordinate your visits to CNC-related vendors around that schedule. You can learn things to ask questions in the seminar, and likely the seminar will provide you information to ask more questions of exhibitors out on the show floor.

Tools to use

Once you are in a presentation, be sure to get the most out of it with some simple tools. First off, be sure to take notes. It's easy to become overwhelmed by the show and not remember all the details until long after the show is over and you suddenly need to recall that key piece of information.

Another great tool is your cell phone. While some presenters make copies of their presentation available, snapping a quick photo of a side or a demonstration process using your cell phone camera can help you remember specifics and go back to

them later.


Be sure to collect contact information for speakers and panelists that you are interested in. Most are more than happy to continue the conversation after the show to help you get the information you need to succeed.

Peer to peer

Being face-to-face is a huge advantage for networking, and don't forget to take advantage of it when you participate in seminars and educational programs. Pay attention to the questions and comments that other attendees make. Try to connect with the ones who share common issues and interests.

Also pay attention to who is presenting and how they are connected to the industry. A number of the presentations are presented in connection with associations such as the Cabinet Makers Association or AWI.

Then, after you've attended the sessions, make a plan to follow up to get even more benefit. Some of that follow-up could be almost immediately on the trade show floor, just a short walk away. There is no substitute for being there.





the Las Vegas Convention Center (LVCC) campus is a first-of-its-kind transportation solution, named the Las Vegas Convention Center Loop. It is now operational and will be available for LVCC conventions including AWFS Fair.

The \$52.5 million system will serve as a fun and quick way to move convention attendees throughout the more than 200-acre campus, all 40 feet beneath the around in all-electric Tesla vehicles. Plans have been announced to develop an expanded system throughout the resort corridor, known as the Vegas Loop, which will ease traffic congestion and offer a new transportation option for visitors from as far north as Downtown Las Vegas, throughout the Strip and as far south as Allegiant Stadium.

The company constructed two oneway, 0.8-mile vehicular tunnels and

three passenger stations to connect the existing convention center campus to the 1.4 million square foot West Hall expansion. The system will allow up to 4,400 convention attendees per hour to be whisked across the sprawling campus in just under two minutes, free of charge. By foot, the walk would take approximately 25 minutes. Instead, passengers are carried in all-electric Tesla vehicles to their destination. Vehicles have capacity to go 150 mph but will travel at 35-40 mph due to the short distance of the tunnels. The system will be staffed with drivers initially with the plan to operate them autonomously in the future.


