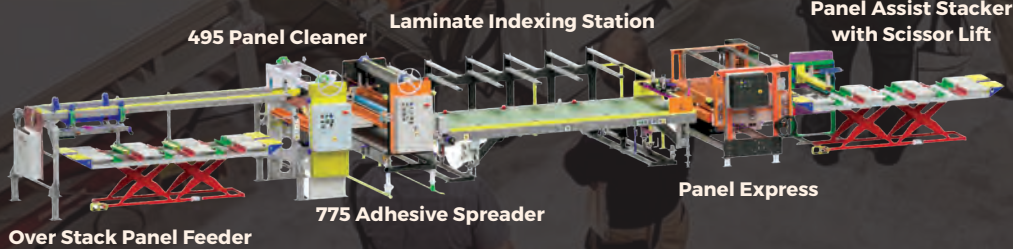

2023 Fresh Wood finalists selected

Association of Woodworking & Furnishings Suppliers (AWFS) has named 40 projects as finalists in the 2023 Fresh Wood competition.

This year, 142 entries were received from high school and post-secondary students throughout the US and Canada. Forty projects from 20 different schools – 10 high schools and 10 post-secondary schools - were selected for the final round of judging, which will take place at the AWFS Fair in Las Vegas, July 25-28.

The students and their instructors whose projects advanced to the final round were invited to attend the AWFS Fair in person, with most of the travel costs covered by AWFS.

In addition to serving on the judging panel, Brian Boggs will provide the 2023 Fresh Wood Best of Show Trophy. The trophy will be displayed at the Fresh Wood booth #2556 and presented to the Best of Show winner at the student awards ceremony on the AWFS Fair LIVE Stage, Booth # 4780, on Thursday, July 27, at 4:00 p.m. The judging panel selects the Best of Show recipient from each category's first-place winner.

WCA to present workforce development solutions

Representatives of the Woodwork Career Alliance of North America (WCA) will tackle the woodworking industry's skilled worker shortage from two different vantage points in conference sessions at the AWFS Fair, July 25-28 in Las Vegas.

Bruce Spitz, a WCA Board of Directors member, and Scott Nelson, president of the WCA, will discuss how woodworking companies can establish an in-house training program or improve an existing one. Greg Larson, vice president of the WCA Board, will explain the multiple benefits school woodworking programs and professional wood products companies can reap by becoming an EDUcation or MANufacturing member of the WCA.

"Building a Training Program for Your Workers," is the title of Spitz's and Nelson's workshop scheduled for 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Tuesday, July 25.

During the workshop, attendees will receive guidance for creating a first-year training template for new hires based on their production shop's unique needs and incorporating the WCA Skill Standards.

Attendees will also learn how to:

- Develop a pre-hire test required for job candidates before employment;
 - Identify the knowledge base skills and machine skills required in the first two years of a hire's employment;
 - Develop a method of training that is best suited for their company and create standard operating procedures to facilitate their training program; and
 - Access quality training resources from the WCA's extensive library of instructional videos, skill activities, and tests.
- Attendees of this program qualify to join the WCA as a MANufacturing member for \$100, a 60% savings on a one-year membership.

Larson's presentation, "Teaching and Evaluating the Wood Industry's Skill Standards," is scheduled for 1:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. Thursday, July 27, as part of the Teacher Track.

A long-time instructor of cabinetmaking at the postsecondary level, Larson will discuss implementing the WCA's credentialing system to create and manage a training program in a school or business.

Larson, a WCA chief evaluator, has successfully used the WCA Skill Standards to shape his curriculum and credential students. He will also address WCA EDUcation and MANufacturing membership benefits, including accessing the WCA's extensive online library of instructional videos, educational materials, and other training resources to help trainers accomplish their goals faster and better.

Larson's presentation is one of five sessions on the Teacher Track that WCA members will lead.

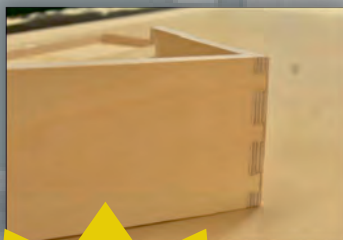

2023 show brings the summer heat

Woodworkers flock to the Las Vegas Convention this week.

Woodworkers, suppliers, machinery manufacturers and more meet this week for AWFS Fair, July 25 to Friday, July 28. This biennial event has become a critical hub for international commerce in the woodworking industry bringing together the home and commercial furnishings industry, including manufacturers and distributors of machinery, hardware, lumber, construction materials and other supplies to furniture, cabinet, closets and home organization, architectural woodwork/millwork, and retail fixtures manufacturers, as well as other custom and production woodworkers.
